Anxious Solitary Youth Come of Age: Interpersonal Processes Link Youth Trajectories to Adjustment Trajectories in Young Adulthood.

This is a young-adult follow-up survey of a longitudinal sample originally followed in youth (funded by the National Institutes of Health or NIH) that involves electronic **data collection**. The remote surveys will continue throughout the year.

Guidelines and responsibilities:

- The main responsibility of practicum students is to assist the current lab team with data collection process. More specifically, organizing data spread sheets, collecting participant data, and assisting with participant contact.
- Computer and reliable internet connection required.
- Strong interpersonal skills required to effectively communicate with lab team members. (Prior work experience desirable).
- Attendance at weekly lab meetings is required.
- Spanish language competence desirable, but not required.


