Postdoctoral Scholar Position Announcement

Job Overview

We invite applications for a Postdoctoral Research Scholar in the Food Safety and Quality Lab at Florida State University. The role encompasses a variety of responsibilities:

- 1. Conducting independent research in the area of food and nutrition.
- 2. Training and supervising both undergraduate and graduate students.
- 3. Overseeing lab management, including procurement of reagents and maintenance of lab equipment.
- 4. Developing scholarly manuscripts, presentations for scientific conferences, and reports for the USDA to disseminate research findings.
- 5. Assisting in identifying funding sources and drafting grant proposals.
- 6. Engaging in relevant teaching activities within the department.
- 7. Performing other research-related tasks as needed.

Minimum Requirements

- 1. A Ph.D. in Food and Nutrition or a related discipline with expertise in areas like chemistry, physicochemistry, immunochemistry, analytical chemistry, biology, and/or food processing.
- 2. Proven track record of scientific research, evidenced by publications in peer-reviewed journals and conference presentations.
- 3. Strong oral and written communication skills.

Preferred Qualifications

- 1. Experience in cell culture and/or *in vivo* experimental research.
- 2. Experience in writing and securing research grants.
- 3. Prior involvement in student mentorship and academic teaching.
